KIGULA SAM: CHAMPION OF JUSTICE IN NAKASONGOLA'S LAND DISPUTES

In Nakasongola District, land disputes and mafia-led intimidation were widespread, leading to false arrests and evictions.

Kigula Sam, in collaboration with the RDC, established a Land Dispute Resolution Committee that meets weekly and has successfully resolved **over 145** long-standing cases, protecting vulnerable families across the district.

NAKASONGOLA PENSIONERS' TRIUMPH: HOW LC5 KIGULA SAM DELIVERED DIGNITY AND BACKLOG PAYMENTS

Under the leadership of LC5 Chairperson Kigula Sam, Nakasongola's pensioners have transitioned from frustration to empowerment.

No longer left to loiter at district offices, they now have a unified voice and a physical hub marking a dramatic shift in how retirees are treated

KEY ACHIEVEMENTS:

- 1. Organized Representation: Established the Nakasongola District Pensioners Association, complete with a furnished office at Nakasongola Town Council.
- 2. Strategic Leadership: Implemented a dedicated committee to streamline communication and service delivery.
- 3. Backlog Cleared: Successfully lobbied for 1.33 billion shillings in FY 2020/2021 to settle all pending pensions and gratuities.
- 4. Payroll Access: Ensured the majority are now on the pension payroll, with proactive outreach to resolve incomplete filings.

EMPOWERING EX-COMBATANTS THROUGH SACCO MOBILIZATION IN NAKASONGOLA

Ex-combatants from the UPDF, Police, and other pensioned officers in Nakasongola formed the Nakasongola Ex-combatants SACCO, now fully registered with about 45 active members.

Through this SACCO, led in part by Kigula Sam, members have mobilized efforts to seek re-employment opportunities for retired

KIGULA SAM SECURES ARMY SUPPORT FOR SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE

Chairman Kigula Sam successfully lobbied the army during the Tarehe Sita National Function, resulting in the construction of a school building at Buyamba Primary School.

This development has greatly improved diagnostic capabilities, enabled quicker and more accurate detection of health conditions and enhanced patient care.






Nakasongola District has undergone a remarkable transformation in financial accountability under the leadership of




